BENEFITS

- 9-week research experience with a \$4,500 stipend

ELIGIBILITY

- Current undergrad, grad, or medical student who identifies as Black / African American
- Priority goes to PA residents but out-of-state students allowed
- Must be full-time student in any year or degree program

APPLICATION

- A cover letter with your name, address, email, and telephone number. As well as your enrolled university, major, and year of study.
 - A one-page essay: (1) background, (2) interest in research or care focused on older adults/persons with Alzheimer's and how this internship will advance your future, and (3) how issues of diversity, equity, and inclusion have informed your education, work, and experience (single-spaced, 12-point font with one-inch margin)
 - Unofficial college transcript
 - Resume
 - Two letters of reference
